



**Italian Personal Data Protection Code, Legislative Decree 196/2003
Information to Data Subjects (Section 13)**

Dear Supplier,

Personal data are protected in Italy under Legislative Decree No. 196 of 30 June 2003 which, amongst other things, provides that data subjects be given the following information regarding the processing of their data.

1. The data controller is OMAS S.r.l. Via Del Fonditore 10, 40138 Bologna (Italy).
2. The data collected will be processed solely for the following purposes:
 - a. Performance of the contract with your company, your firm or you personally
 - b. Preparation of orders, requests for quotations, opinions of a commercial nature and other pre-contract correspondence
 - c. Performance of obligations arising out of legal requirements connected with the contract such as, for example, accounting and tax recording requirements, withholding tax certification, tax returns
 - d. Internal statistical purposes relating to our business operations
 - e. Management surveys connected with our products and services (e.g. stock management)
3. Processing will be based on principles of lawfulness, fairness, utmost confidentiality, transparency and protection of your rights.
Data will be processed, printed and archived, either manually or electronically, by personnel authorized by the data controller and by data processors, adopting suitable security measures.
4. The names of the data processors and persons in charge of the processing are shown in the specific page of our Internet web site.
5. OMAS is subject to the management and control of the Xinyu Hengdeli Ltd. group, based in the People's Republic of China, and the data regarding our suppliers may, for the purposes specified above, be communicated to our mother company.
6. The data may be communicated to third parties such as receiving and paying banks, couriers and forwarding agents, our legal advisors, and other suppliers who perform other stages in the production process, provided always that further processing by these third parties is connected with contract terms and conditions. The data may also be communicated to other persons or entities where communication to such persons or entities is mandatory under current community or national legislation or regulations.
7. The data will not be disseminated.
8. The providing of data by you is voluntary but refusal to provide requested data will make it impossible for us to proceed to processing and, therefore, to perform our obligations under the contract.
9. You may at any time exercise your rights under section 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 (updating, rectification, blocking/erasure of data processed unlawfully) by making an informal request to the data controller to be sent by fax to the following number +39 051 6027936. A suitable response shall be provided to the request without delay.
